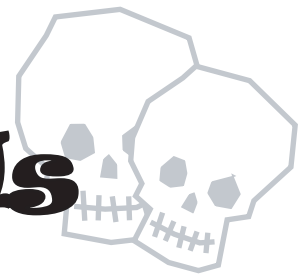


Día de los Muertos Paper Marigolds



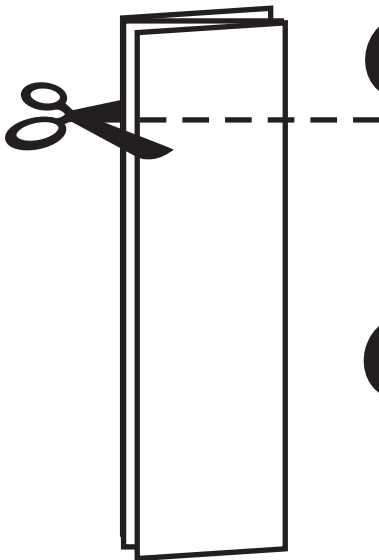
THINGS YOU WILL NEED

Brightly colored crepe paper folds

A pair of scissors

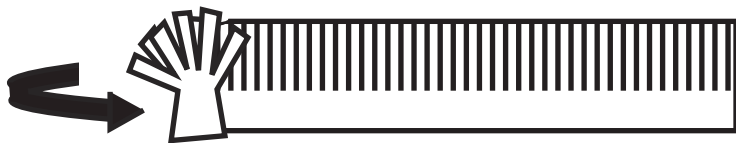
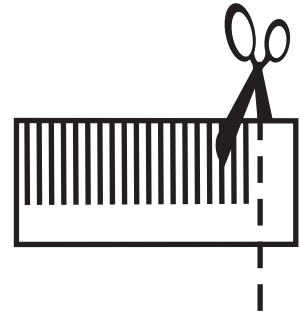
Floral wire (or some other wire that is easy to shape and cut)

Floral tape

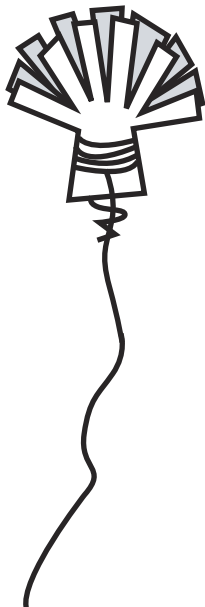


- 1** **Begin** by cutting your folded crepe paper into sections that are about 3" tall. (Use a smaller size for smaller flowers or larger if you want to make larger ones.)

- 2** **Along** one of the long edges of the still folded crepe paper, cut a series of parallel lines 2" long and about 1/2" apart.



- 3** **Unfold** the cut crepe paper and begin rolling it tightly from one end. Pinch the paper, folding as you go, to give the flower form.



- 4** **Tightly** wrap the base of the flower with floral wire. Then attach a second wire, which will form the flower's stem.

- 5** **Cover** the base of the flower and the wire by wrapping with floral tape. Place flower on altar and return to step one.
